

As co-founder of the Alberta Burn Rehabilitation Society, his volunteer activities with burn prevention have led him to host two World Burn Congresses. He also helped Dowzer Communications Group develop their innovative burn & fire prevention program for kids. This commitment to education, awareness and rehabilitation was recognized by the Alberta Medical Association in 1994, when he was awarded a Medal of Honor for his work.

COUNCILS AND COMMITTEES:

As a trusted advisor in the industry Peter is active with many national and international committees, working towards congruent and comprehensive practices. He is on the Industry Advisory Committee with the U of A Research Project: Clothing Systems for Protection Against Steam and Hot Condensate, a newly recognized challenge in the PPE world.
